All US military assigned or attached to ARSOA who served in this area for more than two weeks are directed to complete the exposure on their DO Form 2700, Post Deployment Health Assessment (PDHA) and DO Form 2900 Post Deployment Health Re-Assessment (PDHRA). Additionally, members who experience symptoms (shortness of breath, rashes, unintentional weight loss, fatigue, memory concerns, etc.) should consult with their Flight Surgeon or Aeromedical Physician Assistant and specifically mention exposure to elevated levels of particulate matter noted above during their deployment.
